

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation

Each year on September 30, National Day for Truth and Reconciliation honors the children who didn't return from residential schools, as well as survivors, their families, and communities.

Orange Shirt Day, led by Indigenous communities, aims to raise awareness about the inter-generational impacts of residential schools and allows us all to show our support for the Every Child Matters movement.

As there are no classes on Monday, September 29 and Tuesday, September 30, we welcome staff and students to wear orange on Friday, September 26.



Outdoor Changes:

We have been making some changes at the school to support safety and supervision. Here are a few updates:

- All students are eating at the same time, and going outside at the same time. This provides more adults to supervise students.
- Added orange tape in the woods/bushes as a visual to show students our boundaries
- Grade 4-6 students are now using the main doors as their entrance in the school in the morning, after recess, and after lunch. This provides more supervision and quicker entry in the school.
- All students are welcome to play on the field. We are seeing P-6 students playing soccer, tag on the field.
