### 1) Finances

- PTO \$3500

2) School Data Plan: literacy and math - Discussed the plan for the year. Region is collecting data a little differently. Collecting data meeting/not meeting in literacy halfway through the term. Will pull report card data at the end of term. Next meeting, we will have literacy and last year's Grade 3 data to show.

School Success Plan - new P-2 curriculum for Language Arts, new curriculum coming in for Grade 3-6 students as well. Time at staff meetings will be spent learning new curricula.

### 3) School Overview:

- Class reconfiguration - An extra classroom teacher was added. Moved approximately 70 students. Met as a staff to reconfigure classes, class schedules. A few concerns at the time, but things are mostly settled now. Staff
- Cafeteria change - Chartwells has taken over our cafeteria. Food is following the provincial menu. Feedback re: food has been positive.
- Technology needs\* - With our new class, we need to buy more ChromeBooks to support student learning. Other classes, there are ChromeBooks which are older and need to be replaced.( 5 ChromeBooks proposal). New iPads are in and getting set up. Should be available for student use soon.
- Lunch changes (return of cafeteria) - One lunch time instead of two. Everyone eats at the same time, then go outside all together. Students are eating in classrooms currently. Finishing out the plan, with staff and student input, on how to get back into the cafeteria. Going to start with Gr 2-6, on a schedule, as a privilege, not a requirement.
- Communications to weekly emails - Weekly email to families, which is also posted to the school website as well as a text message letting families know that communication regarding the coming week is out.
- Monthly class visits. - Monthly class visits by John and Kelly, topics that we will bring to discuss with the students, as well as any topics that the students want to bring up.
- Rodent concern from last year - Brought up with Operations, as well as a thorough school walk through to examine any specific spots of concern. Any evidence is being cleaned as we go. We are navigating and staying on top of them as we go.
