1) Finances

2) School Success Plan

Literacy: Writing: Cross curricular focus (outdoor learning , parent survey)

Math: Computational Fluency: Assess learning, plan activities, support all learners where they are.

Wellness: Conflict Resolution - Aimee Clark has been making presentations in each class.

3) School Overview:

- Red Dress Day, Black Excellence day. Model of early assembly and activities on the day.
- Staffing/next year 15 classes (2 PP, 13 P-6) Same as this year. First round of staffing done.

- Curriculum night? Night before school opens? Continue? → *Generally positive feedback. Liked coming in the night before. Allowed students to come, bring belongings, see their classroom. Lowered first day anxiety.*
- Winter concert? One concert not 2? → *Gym capacity would allow for 1 night. Shorter night with 1 concert. Families/staff having to come 2 nights. Ticketing would be an option.*
- School day change- moving recess 30 min later in the am (2 hr block, 15 min recess, 15 min min block, 1 hr instruction, 50 min lunch, 1.5 hr instruction. Bell times don't change for start and end of day → *No problems foreseen. Support for students being more attentive in the morning, as well as moving lunch later by half an hour.*
